In case of emergency

Who to contact during a power outage

For a fault or emergency related to power infrastructure (poles, wires, meters, power outages, etc.) or gas (gas leaks or other emergencies), please contact your distributor for assistance. You can find your distributor details at the top right corner of your bill.

Different companies distribute power to various locations across Australia. They are your first contact for reporting a power outage in your area.

If you already know the name of your distributor, you can find their contact details below or if you are unsure what distributor services your area, you can find this information on the Australian Energy Regulator <u>website</u>.
